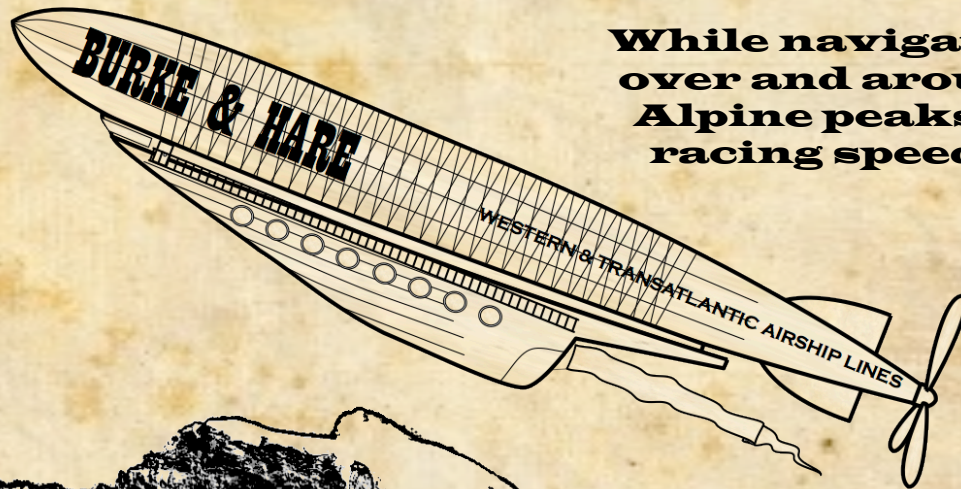
1st MULTINATIONAL AIRSHIP REGATTA
